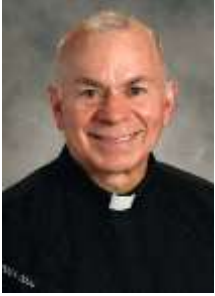

## *From A Grateful Heart*



The hired tenants seized the owner's son, threw him out of the vineyard, and killed him. So what will the owner of the vineyard do to them when he comes to collect his harvest?" The chief priests and elders of the people answered: "He will put those wretched men to a wretched death and lease his vineyard to other tenants who will give him the produce at the proper times." Jesus said to them, "Did you never read in Scripture: The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; by the Lord has this wonder been done? (Psalm 118:22), Therefore, I say to you, the Kingdom of God will be **taken away from you** and given to those who will produce good fruit." (Mt. 21:37-43)



### Jesus Warns the Leaders of Faith to be Faith-filled!

As I look back on my seven years in graduate school it amazes me how much I read, wrote and studied in the course of a four months (the length of a semester). Perhaps it was not similar to growing a vineyard or cultivating the finest grape shoots to produce a fine wine. But, it did have to be constant work to produce a worthy product (a good grade).

I was never good at reading. Later, I realized I am dyslexic! [They didn't test for that in the 1960s]. So, as I struggled to learn the secondary benefit was that my disability became lessened. I remember proof reading a classmates paper for him as we waited to go to the graduation practice at the Seminary. He couldn't believe how fast I read his paper. I proved that I read with understanding by pointing out three places where I believe he had erred on the theology. HE WAS AMAZED! When I realized what I had done, then, – I Was Amazed!

Hard work had produced good fruit. I was able to help my classmate in a way I never could when I graduated from high school – 39 years earlier.

In our Gospel, this weekend, Jesus is confronted and challenged by the chief priests and scholarly scribes of the Temple. He tells them three parables to impress upon them the unfaithfulness of their teaching. They have abandon the Laws of God to demand obedience to them, as the religion they attribute to Moses. They are hypocrites to the Word of God! Now they challenge Jesus' words as false teachings. Jesus' anger boils over as he tells them that the moral of those parables points directly at them and predicts God's punishment of taking away their ministry all-together.

Jesus reminds us that all that we have comes as a gift from God. Even the ability to make a living comes from God. That, then, makes even our financial earning possible because of our gifts from God. Our faith needs to get from Church to the home to the work place. Our love and forgiveness of others is a form of stewardship that calls us to care for each other (You are your brother's keeper!). *See = Genesis 4:9. Our life, our talents and our freedom are all gifts from God. They can be taken away, or lost, if we forget God's centrality in our life! Let our Faith be fully in our life and lived every day.*

As we all look to guard our health this fall, we have an opportunity for you to conveniently get your flu shot safely. Walgreens will be conducting a flu shot clinic in the parking lot on **Thursday, October 8, from 2:00-4:00 PM**. Walgreens will process your insurance coverage (most insurance companies fully cover the flu shot). If you do not have insurance, or for children under 18 years old on state health coverage, the cost is \$36. The clinic will take place in tents outdoors, and socially distance to insure safety.
