

St. Thomas Aquinas, The Theologian, demonstrated that faith and reason are not at odds, as they come from the same source.


St. Catherine of Siena, the Mystic, gave testimony to the reality of the spiritual dimension here and beyond.

Who: For those who want to dig deeper into the lives of those listed. Questions will prompt at home study aided by your Bible and Catechism of the Catholic Church.


