It has been 1,988 years since The Last Supper and the Novus Ordo is still a celebration of Christ's disciples gathered in prayer and in obedience to Jesus' commands to "Pray always" and "Do this in remembrance of me." We call it The Mass. The reason and purpose have never changed, but the form and language used have gone through many changes since Christ's ascension to Heaven.
